### ***What happens next....***

Once you have completed the application form and the data consent form, and returned both to the Hon Secretary, the application will be considered by the Committee. If the next Committee meeting is some way off, the application will be considered by the Committee via email.

Once the application has been approved, the Hon. Secretary will write to you to ask for your annual subscription. You will also be sent a copy of the Club Rules and Constitution, the current season's Fixture List if you join after March, and for playing members, four Club stickers to put on your bowls. If you haven't purchased your bowls yet, keep the stickers until you have.

Dress Code for all Club matches and competitions is Club shirt with grey or white (as explained in the Rules) trousers/skirt/cropped trousers. Your first shirt is subsidised by the Club and you may purchase this at half price. Once your application has been approved, you will be contacted to arrange for you to order the size you want.

Full members are required to hold a key to the Clubhouse and Main Gate. Keys are numbered and of a type which cannot be replicated at a locksmiths. A deposit of £10 is required which will be added to your subscription. The deposit is refundable when the key is returned, which it must of course be if you leave the Club.

The whole process, from sending in your form to receiving your acceptance letter should not take more than a few weeks. ***No fees are payable until your application is approved***
